Dear CCD First Holy Communion Parents,

The faculty and staff of Saint David Catholic Church continue to pray for your good health and peace during these trying times.

Following the guidelines set by the Archdiocese of Miami and under the guidance of Father Steve, we have scheduled CCD First Holy Communion for Saturday, September 12. You will find your assigned Rehearsal schedule and Mass time at the bottom of this letter. No changes will be made to this schedule. Please refer to the attached mandates which must be followed in order to maintain the safety of the children and their families.

Participation in both First Holy Communion Rehearsals is mandatory. Upon completion, you will receive 6 passes per family that must be presented at the Church door in order to attend Mass. In an effort to accommodate all families, there will be no exceptions to the maximum family count of six tickets. Children aged two and under will not require a ticket.

First Holy Communion Mass: Saturday, September 12

First Holy Communion Safety Guidelines



Please note: the Rehearsal and Mass dates are subject to change depending on the Archdiocese and CDC health regulations.

Participation in both scheduled rehearsals are mandatory.

Masks must be worn by everyone entering the Church, including First Communion students. This applies to the rehearsals, as well as during Mass. No one will be admitted without a mask.

Families must remain in their seats at all times, except when receiving Communion.

No pictures or videos may be taken at any time during the Mass.

No one will be admitted without a ticket. There will be no exceptions to this.

Absolutely no food or drinks are permitted in the Church.

Please maintain a safe distance from others before and after Mass.

Each family will be preassigned a pew based on an arbitrary lottery completed by Saint David staff. Families may only use their six tickets to sit in their assigned rows. No additional seating will be available. The children will be given an envelope containing the families' tickets and pew assignment following the second rehearsal. Due to safety requirements, no exceptions will be made.

Under the guidance of Father Steve, we will make every effort to ensure the safety of the children and their families. Please be considerate of others by remaining home if you are not well or have health concerns that may compromise your safety by being in a public setting with others.

All First Holy Communion Masses will be live streamed and available to celebrate from the comfort of your home. The link will be provided following the second rehearsal, as well as on our website.
